

OUR STORY

More than six decades later, a small group of entrepreneurs sparked the revival of “The Good Stuff”. In 2006, Templeton Rye began selling “The Good Stuff” legally for the first time. Templeton Rye quickly made its mark in the whiskey industry and the community of Templeton, where the company built its first finishing and bottling facility in 2007. Templeton Rye has received many significant accolades in the spirits industry, achieved its one-million bottle mark, and shared its spirits across the nation and the world. In August 2018, Templeton Rye marked the next chapter in its spirited story by opening a new modern production facility and distillery in Templeton. The facility was built with great care to recognize and celebrate the community and people who first brought “The Good Stuff” to life. Templeton Rye’s new production facility includes the distillery, aging warehouse and visitor center.

IOWA LEGENDARY RYE

Each run of Iowa Legendary Rye is created in small batches, hand-crafted just like grandma use to make. Using the recipe that one of Templeton, Iowa's original bootleggers, Lorine Sextro, used when her family farm was home to a closely guarded secret distilling operation, Iowa Legendary Rye is mashed, distilled and bottled on site in Carroll. The rye grain is grown right here in Carroll County by local farmer, Brian Iribek. The stills have been custom built based on old-school technology, giving Iowa Legendary Rye an authentic rye taste. Each bottle is hand labeled and individually numbered so you know exactly which barrel aged your one-of-a-kind bottle of rye.

Iowa Legendary Rye is located in the former Rupiper Four-Star grocery building, Carroll Apothecary and Stone's Printing Office Products moved into the building in 1984. Iowa Legendary Rye opened in 2014.

WHAT CAN YOU GET

The White Rye (White Label)
The White Rye is distilled in small batches of 26 gallon stills. These stills have been custom built, giving the rye its authentic, historically accurate taste – the real deal!

The Aged Rye (Black Label)
The Aged Rye has been aged in custom-made barrels, giving it a rich, caramel taste with hints of vanilla, honey and spice.

The Private Reserve (Red Label)
The Private Reserve is aged in two of the same custom-made barrels that are used for the Aged Rye. Due to this process, it has many of the same notes and undertones as the Aged with a very smooth finish.

The Vodka
Iowa Legendary Rye Vodka is truly unique – distilled using a modified vodka flute on the same custom stills that produce the distillery's spectacular rye. It is then re-distilled and charcoal filtered for purity.





OUR STORY

Santa Maria Vineyard & Winery is located in downtown Carroll. A family owned and operated winery, Santa Maria Vineyard & Winery was established in 2005 when an old car dealership was converted into a Tuscan winery. Taste over 30 different wines, ranging from dry to sweet, big bold reds to light and fruity whites inside or relax in the courtyard or in front of one of the fireplaces. Also located in the old Santa Maria Winery is Carroll's newest steakhouse. Enjoy delicious food in an amazing setting. Santa Maria Vineyard & Winery and Baratta's Steakhouse are located in the old Swaney Automobile dealership that was constructed on three lots on the corner of Sixth and Carroll Streets in 1913. It expanded west of the garage for oil business and a gas station, the first in Carroll in 1915. It housed Mackey Motors Incorporated, the oldest Ford Motor Company in the state in 1930, as well as Cliff McCarville Insurance Agency from 1942-1943, John Whaley Chevrolet from 1968-1970, and Wittrock Motors from 1970-2005.

OUR STORY

Just one block off of Highway 30 in downtown Carroll, Carroll Brewing Company is housed in the historic brick building that was formerly a steam plant on the corner of North Clark and East Fifth streets. It serves mainly as a distribution company, but also features a taproom with a full bar offering up to 30 beers made only in Carroll. The core beers include a light lager, an American red ale and a cream ale. The building housed the first heat and light plant built here in 1900 and then renovated and expanded in 1924. The engine area and the boiler room inside the buildings were entirely open. At one time the building contained steam engines. A 16x20 diesel engine was installed in the west end and in 1938 a second diesel engine was installed on the east side. In early days the plant required a total of six operators for a 24 hour schedule. The historic building once had a 150 foot cement smokestack.





WHAT CAN YOU GET

Our taproom is housed in the same building as our brewery and has a 100-seat capacity. The atmosphere maintains much of the character of the historic space with exposed brick, original floors and a custom-built bar made out of 100-year old reclaimed retail pieces. Plus, with 30 draft lines, there's a beer on tap for everyone. If beer isn't your style, try some hard cider or local wine. Stop in and pull up a seat — we'd love to say hello.
